

SETUP – DISTRICT WEBSITE CONFIGURATION

IT Requirements

- Pass through all content from publicschoolorworks.com. Note, if this is not an option, please contact the PublicSchoolWORKS, IT Department at (513) 631-6111 or khansel@publicschoolworks.com.
- Accept all emails (including HTML email content and attachments) from publicschoolorworks.com. If you cannot white list a domain name and require an IP address please accept all emails from 64.18.218.22 and 64.18.218.150.
- Ensure that no content from publicschoolorworks.com is cached (e.g., by proxy servers or by individual computers).
- Do not open PublicSchoolWORKS within a frame. Opening PublicSchoolWORKS in a frame may affect the proper functioning of the software. Open PublicSchoolWORKS in a new window.

User Computer Requirements

- Computers must accept cookies from PublicSchoolWORKS.
- Due to the increasing use of popup blocking software, PublicSchoolWORKS has been designed using popups in very limited situations, such as displaying “Help” information. To give employees full access to online help files, PublicSchoolWORKS should be excluded from pop-up-blocking software.
- Employees will need Flash Player to view the online safety training courses. Ensure district computers have Flash Player or that it can be downloaded on individual computers.

Website Links

The links below can be used by a district to provide staff access to the various tools, support and functionality of PublicSchoolWORKS. To make it easy for staff to access the services (e.g., online training) and to stress to the public the district’s proactive approach to health and safety, the district should consider locating a link on the front page of the district website called:
